Special camaraderie through our monthly luncheons with noted speakers and <u>your lunch is free the month of your birth</u>; our annual Military Ball; quarterly Officers Calls; and community events. Membership also includes a commitment from the Chapter and MOAA National for support to Surviving Spouses of MOAA and NWFMOA members.

NWFMOA's Community Outreach: As a 501(c)19, Veteran Organization, we solely focus on the needs of those presently serving and those who have served. Our recent Community Outreach initiatives include: 2018: Veterans Stand Down; 2019: Purchased kitchen equipment for One Hopeful Place Homeless Shelter; 2020, 2021, & 2022: Purchased commissary gift cards for distribution to E4 and below enlisted families at Thanksgiving; 2022, we partnered with the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) and purchased and placed wreaths on Veterans' graves. In 2023, we purchased commissary gift cards for 300 junior enlisted families, Veteran Stand Down--clothed 65 Homeless Veterans, Wreaths Across America--purchased and placed 66 wreaths on Veteran graves, and unveiled a new initiative... Valentines for Veterans.

<u>Scholarships</u>: We award multiple scholarships to JROTC cadets at 7 local high schools and college ROTC cadets through our NWFMOA Scholarship Fund [IRS 501C(3) non-profit]. We have awarded over \$140,000 since 2015.

<u>Advocacy:</u> We maintain contact with our Federal, State, and local elected officials regarding issues that impact Veteran and Retiree earned benefits and the quality of life of those serving.
