Our recent Community Outreach initiatives include: 2020, 2021, & 2022: Purchased commissary gift cards for distribution to E-4 and below enlisted families at Thanksgiving; 2022: we partnered with the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) and purchased and placed wreaths on Veterans' graves. 2023: We again purchased gift cards for enlisted families, partnered with the DAR, and unveiled a new initiative...*Valentines for Vets*. 2024: In addition to the 2023 activities, we celebrated our 65th Anniversary with a free community reception at the Air Force Armament Museum.

Scholarships: We award multiple scholarships to JROTC cadets at 7 local high schools and college ROTC cadets through our NWFMOA Scholarship Fund [IRS 501(c)(3) non-profit]. We have awarded over \$150,000 since 2015.

Advocacy: We maintain contact with our Federal, State, and local elected officials regarding issues that impact Veteran and Retiree earned benefits and the quality of life of those serving.
