

**Scholarships:** We award multiple scholarships to JROTC cadets at 7 local high schools and college ROTC cadets through our NWFMOA Scholarship Fund [IRS 501(c)(3) non-profit]. We have awarded over \$150,000 since 2015.

<u>Advocacy:</u> We maintain contact with our Federal, State, and local elected officials regarding issues that impact Veteran and Retiree earned benefits and the quality of life of those serving.
